Chardonnay

Bilyara Chardonnay (S.E. Aust) Our cellar selected house pour. A soft, round and light Chardonnay style, there is minimal oak and the melon and faintly yeast influenced fruit does the talking.	5.80	27.00
Yalumba `Wild Ferment' Chardonnay (Barossa - S.A.) The palate is brimming with creamy stone-fruit flavours with a crisp lemony brightness, fine toasty oak nuances and a refreshing finish.	6.80	31.00
Schild Estate Unwooded Chardonnay (Barossa - S.A.) Some fresh melons and tropical characters forward on the nose followed by hints of lime blossoms.	6.50	30.00
Vasse Felix Chardonnay (Margaret River – WA) This classic Margaret River Chardonnay is full bodied with good fruit sweetness and depth, with the palate very typical of luscious Chardonnay, finely structured by fresh acidity and green apple flavours. Wild fermentation and lees stirring offers texture and richness to this perfectly balanced wine.		39.00
Pirie `Estate' Chardonnay (Tamar Valley - Tasmania) The colour is that luminescent green-gold which appears to be prerequisite for top, Young chardonnay. Aromas of nutty lemon tart are balanced by careful use of oak and significant malo-lactic characters, both of which also contribute to the textural complexity of the palate which displays lemon butter and butterscotch.		45.00
Ingolby Chardonnay (McLaren Vale SA) Shows fresh straw colours in the glass. Aromas of fig, peach and melon with a subtle hint of oak and present on the nose. These scents develop into elegant yet powerful flavours of fig and peach on the palate. This wine has a well-balanced, creamy finish in the mouth.	6.50	30.00

Sails

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Riesling

Rosemount Diamond Label Riesling (S.E. Aust) 6.50 29.00
The nose is fresh and lifted, like the scent of ripe stone fruits.
The palate is highly appealing with a distinctive zest of lime-fresh acidity giving way to a peachy softness with hints of mango and apples.

Annie's Lane Riesling (Clare Valley - S.A.) 7.00 32.00
The nose shows the classic lime, citrus and fresh spring flowers supported by a steely, mineral, flinty backbone on the lingering finish.

Peter Lehman Riesling (Eden Valley - S.A.) 6.50 30.00
This is a fantastic example of a cool climate Riesling with a zesty lime and lemon driven palate, it finishes crisp and clean showing the wonderful crisp mineral acidity typical of top Eden Valley Riesling.

Pirie South Riesling (Tamar Valley - Tasmania) 7.50 34.00
Light gold. The aroma is very delicate and fragrant with mandarin and lily-flower. The palate is pure cool climate Riesling: light and fresh, with a long taste of crushed flowers and citrus fruits; fruit sweetness is balanced by fresh, cool-climate acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc

Maven Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough - N.Z) 7.00 32.00
Lifted aromas of passionfruit and gooseberries abound. A lively wine with flavours of melon and lime with rich, ripe tropical fruit and a lingering crisp finish.

Matua Valley Sauvignon Blanc (Hawkes Bay N.Z.) 7.00 32.00
Green apple, lemon citrus with some sweet confectionary aromas on the nose. The palate is zesty with generous citrus fruit characters.

Giesen Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough - N.Z) 7.50 34.00
Classic nettle and gooseberry flavours combined with dry, minerally flavours on a medium bodied palate. Fresh, vibrant ripe pip-fruit and citrus flavours and succulent, punchy fruit intensity. Focused acidity provides length and zest to the finish.

Pirie Sauvignon Blanc (Tamar Valley - Tasmania) 8.00 36.00
Pale straw in colour. The bouquet shows marked mineral elements and kiwi fruit. The palate has good weight and intensity displaying greengages, a strong mineral backbone and taught acidity leading to a long finish.

Crowded House Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough - N.Z) 6.50 30.00
A great wine showing hints of tropical, passionfruit and stone fruits with just a touch of typical Marlborough grassiness. The palate has outstanding intensity. The wine is dry and has a rich fruit driven mid palate, with a long clean finish.

Other Varietals

T'Gallant Juliet Pinot Grigio (Yarra Valley - Vic) 6.50 30.00
Pale gold in colour, it has a clean savory palate - green olive and wild honey. Lifted aromas of musk, pear and salt air - vibrant and delicious.

Lindemans Early Harvest Classic Dry White (Murray Darling - SA) 6.00 29.00
A fun lunch time wine low in calories and only 9% alcohol. Pale straw with green hues in colour, the nose shows white peach and tropical fruit aromas. Its light bodied palate is balanced by a crisp, refreshing clean finish.

Vasse Felix Classic Dry White (Margaret River - W.A.) 39.00
Zesty, citrus flower, nettle, fresh passion fruit and exotic tropical spice provide lifted aromatics. The nose offers good purity of primary fruit with clean attractive flavours making this wine a classic Margaret River style.

Pirie South Pinot Gris (Tamar Valley - Tasmania) 7.50 34.00
Pale gold but with Pinot Gris tell-tale slight bronze stain, the nose is a heady concoction of exotic spices and potpourri. In the mouth, the wine has good weight and a velvety texture, but is dry and clean on the finish.

Fruity Whites

Brown Brothers Crouchen Riesling (Milawa - Vic) 6.00 28.00
This wine is pale show in colour with youthful green tinges. The nose is lifted with aromas of passionfruit, ripe pear and peach. The aromas follow through to the palate which is mouth filling with natural grape sweetness and a crisp balancing finish.

Wolf Blass Red Label Traminer Riesling (S. E. Aust) 5.80 27.00
If it's a fruity white your looking for then try this one....



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Shiraz

Bilyara Shiraz (S. E. Aust)	5.80	27.00
Our cellar selected house pour. Aroma of warm soft plums and ripe figs. Smooth velvety taste of ripewarm slightly spicy plums with overtones of peppers and vanilla.		
Pepper Jack Shiraz (Barossa – S.A.)	7.50	35.00
Aromas of blackberry and plum are supported by pepper and spice characters on the nose. The rich, round, soft palate shows concentrated berry fruit, complex oak and star anise notes. This wine is intricate and elegant with velvety tannins and great length of flavor.		
Mitchell Pepper Tree Shiraz (Clare Valley – S.A.)	8.50	39.00
very well handled wine that slowly opens to reveal brightness and length. Its meaty, spicy aromas of red berries and plums are backed by spicy, peppery undertones of cinnamon and nutmeg, with charcuterie-like undertones.		
Richmond Grove Shiraz (Barossa – S.A.)	7.00	32.00
Shiraz is the classic red grape of the Barossa. This wine has intense flavours and robust structure. It is full bodied with rich fruit flavour balanced by fine oak tannin through to a long silken finish.		
Schild Estate Shiraz (Barossa – S.A.)		32.00
Royal purple hues over deep red. Bouquet of ripe red berries, liquorice and spice. To the palate the rich plummy fruit which are deep and rewarding, with tannins that are soft yet abundant, and howing a hint of vanillin oak .		
Fox Creek Red Baron Shiraz (McLaren Vale –S.A.)		31.99
Rich soft entry leads into blend of fresh red berry, cherry and plum fruits framed with smooth ripe tannins. A very soft and full mid palate with sweet ripe fruit, subtle balanced oak with juicy well developed length.		

Cabernet Sauvignon & Blends

Pepper Jack Cabernet Sauvignon (Barossa -S.A.)	7.50	35.00
Plum red in the glass. Aromas of blackcurrants and spice develop into an elegant palate with a hint of mint and cedar. The rich full-bodied palate shows great structure and balance with a backbone of cedary oak and well-integrated tannins.		
Penfolds Bin 407 Cabernet Sauvignon (S.A.)		49.00
Dense deep red. An aromatic, and distinctly Cabernet Sauvignon nose leaps out of the glass. Wafts of asian spices, dried lemongrass, star anise and blackcurrant arise with air, dusty oak notes oscillate in and out.		
Robertsons Well Cabernet Sauvignon (Coonawarra – S.A.)	7.00	32.00
The style is big, rich and flavoursome. The bouquet is full of black currants and spice and the flavour long with drying tannins to finish. This is a classic Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon.		
Penfolds Bin 389 Cabernet Shiraz (S.A.)		58.00
Brooding, tight, grainy, dusty blackcurrant and tobacco and plums, which with time also offer up the scent of violets, even pepper.		
Wynns Estate Cabernet Shiraz Merlot (Coonawarra – S.A.)		32.00
Deep ruby with brick red tinges. A fragrant, slightly gamey nose with fresh, ripe berry fruit and spice with well-integrated oak. The palate is highlighted by the upfront, bright cassis fruit flavours of Cabernet.		
Peter Lehman `Clancy's' Shiraz, Cabernet & Merlot (Barossa, S.A.)	6.50	30.00
Peter Lehman winemakers follow the long Australian tradition of blending shiraz with Cabernet Sauvignon but giving their unique touch with the incorporation of Merlot to give a soft, approachable and richly enjoyable red wine.		
Metala White Label Shiraz Cabernet (Langhorne Creek – S.A.)		32.00
This luxuriant blend of Shiraz and Cabernet carries the lauded hallmarks of the Langhorne district, sublime berry flavours, an entrancing colour, mint with eucalypt nuances and a divine, light woodiness. This wine won the inaugural Jimmy Watson Trophy		

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Merlot & Cabernet Merlot

Annie's Lane Cabernet Merlot (Clare Valley - S.A.)	6.50	30.00
Fragrant aromas of blackcurrant, violets and berries develop into a rich, soft palate balanced with subtle integrated oak and refined tannins for a lingering fruit finish.		
Cartwheel Cabernet Merlot (Margaret River, W.A.)		34.00
Spicy Cabernet and smooth, luscious Merlot perfectly combined.		
Schild Estate Merlot (Barossa - S.A.)	7.00	32.00
Dark red with crimson hues. plumbs, mulberries & a hint of savoury oak. On the palate it is rich full bodied dark cherry & raspberry with slight tobacco leaf undertones, generous & lush.		
Jamiesons Run Merlot (Coonawarra - S.A.)	6.50	30.00
Varietal aromas of dark cherry, spicy plums, and blackberry with a soft finish.		

Pinot Noir

Pirie South Pinot Noir (Tamar Valley - Tasmania)	7.50	34.00
Still deep ruby in colour, cocoa and coffee bean barrel aromas give way to the perfumes of spicy black cherry and plum. In the mouth, the soft richness of the pinot noir fruit is balanced by the taut, fine-grained and dry tannins on the finish, with some early signs of the gamey, earthy complexity.		
Matua Valley Marlborough Pinot Noir (Marlborough - N.Z.)	8.00	36.00
Vibrant light cherry red in colour, the nose exhibits perfumed violet aromas complementing sweet cherry fruit. The palate displays soft, rich sweet fruit, balanced with integrated lingering oak.		
2004 Pirie 'Estate' Pinot Noir (Tamar Valley - Tasmania)		45.00
Still deep ruby in colour, cocoa and coffee bean barrel aromas give way to the perfumes of spicy black cherry and plum. In the mouth, the soft richness of the pinot noir fruit is balanced by the taut, fine-grained and dry tannins on the finish, with some early signs of the gamey, earthy complexity which will develop with further bottle age.		
Bass Strait Pinot Noir (Tasmania)	7.00	33.00
A medium bodied wine which shows typical varietal characters of wild cherries with a hint of plum complemented with a touch of vanillian oak on the mid palate. The finish is well rounded with excellent balance of acidity and tannins.		

Dessert

Peter Lehman Botrytis Semillon 375ml (S.A.)		29.00
A fantastic Botrytis Semillon which is sweet with amazing freshness, wonderful flavours and tantalising complexity.		
Debortoli Noble One Botrytis Semillon 375ml (Yarra Valley - Vic)		39.00
The ultimate dessert wine... One of the world's most awarded wines accumulating over 320 Gold Medals, 98 Trophies and 95 International Awards including being three times winner of the International Wine and Spirit Competition for 'Best Botrytis Wine'. The Semillon grapes used in De Bortoli's 'Noble One' are infected with a mould called botrytis cinerea which concentrates the grape flavours and sugars, producing rich, luscious, intensely sweet dessert wines.

1999 Yattarna Chardonnay	97.00
<p>Complex and tightly structured, with intense lime and grapefruit on the front palate, which slowly changes into a mixture of citrus and pear. Finely chiselled acidity, cedary oak and yeastiness gives excellent depth and graciously offset the richly textured underlying fruit. Finely interwoven and seamlessly presented, this is a standout Chardonnay of impeccable pedigree with an extended, elegant finish. Ideally suited to chicken & seafood.</p>	
1998 Penfolds Bin 98a Chardonnay	75.00
<p>Richly flavored wine showing ripe melon and pineapple fruit flavours typical of the vintage. Use of cooler climate fruit ensured good natural acid balance, with a beautiful weave of savory oak and creamy malolactic secondary characters adding depth and complexity to the sustained, rich finish. Ideally suited to chicken & seafood</p>	
1997 Grange Bin 95	449.00
<p>Immediately engaging, with wafts of nutmeg and ginger amongst notes of blueberry & Blackcurrant and a background of well seasoned savory oak. The wine is opulently textured, extremely soft, layered, and seductive, with Grange's tell-tale personality well-displayed, but in a seamless, seductive style. Ideally suited to Beef.</p>	
1998 Grange Bin 95	549.00
<p>The nose is youthful and intense with dark ripened Satsuma plum fruits rising above a base of liquored dark chocolate and licorice. Overtones of malt, toasty barrel ferment and nutty oak meld effortlessly into an exquisitely aromatic offering. Its harmony, freshness, and remarkable length suggest this wine is an all-time classic. Ideally suited to Beef.</p>	
1999 Grange Bin 95	449.00
<p>Blackberry & blueberry fruit interwoven with perfectly tuned, malty, savory oak, with licorice and anise notes hovering above. Complexity with deep rich colour and fine grained tannins court a firm tight finish of great length. Ideally suited to Beef.</p>	
2001 Grange Bin 95	499.00
<p>The nose is immediately Grange... Revealing barrel ferment complexities soaked in dark berried fruits. Beautifully balanced, this 100% Barossa wine delivers the expectation demanded of Grange. Ideally suited to Beef.</p>	
2002 Grange Shiraz Bin 95	499.00
<p>Deep, closed and brooding, with perfectly ripened aromas of dark berries, plums and typical smoky cedar/vanilla/dark chocolate Penfolds oak that become more fragrant with aeration, revealing scents of violets, cloves and cinnamon.</p>	
Magill Estate Shiraz (vintages available from '00 - '03)	from 85.00
<p>A medium weight palate with mulberry and raspberry tightly contained by tannins that literally coat the whole mouth. Charming, balanced and long lingering flavours. Great mouth feel and texture with a driving fruit intensity.</p>	
RWT Shiraz (vintages available from '99 - '03)	from 120.00
Bin 707 Cabernet Sauvignon (vintages available from '82 - '03)	from 130.00
St Henri Shiraz (vintages available from '97 - '02)	from 80.00
1999 Lindemans St George Cabernet Sauvignon	from 55.00
<p>This illustrious wine is full bodied, complex and intense with the ability to age gracefully. The harvested fruit displayed ripe, intense flavours and pronounced but fine tannins. .</p>	
Wynns Coonawarra John Riddoch Cabernet Sauvignon (vintages available from '93 & '99)	from 75.00
<p>Matured in French oak for up to 26 months, in its youth John Riddoch is intense, almost black in colour. Rich, ripe and complex, the bouquet is a voluptuous infusion of red berry, chocolate, mint, mushroom and cassis-like cabernet aromas merging with lifted, spicy new oak. It is full-bodied with persistent and mouth-filling ripe berry flavour and excellent structure.</p>	

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Wynns Coonawarra `Michael' Shiraz (vintages available from '94 & '98)	85.00
Earning a reputation as the benchmark Coonawarra shiraz, Michael is fermented and then matured in new American oak for up to 18 months. It is deep red in colour with strong mulberry, peppery shiraz berry aromas enriched with coffee bean American oak character in the nose.	
1998 DeBortoli `Melba Reserve'	65.00
Melba is a 90 / 10 blend of cabernet sauvignon and merlot. Pencil lead, iron, vanilla, coffee, blackberry jam and rootsy resin flavours preview its coffee, smoky plum jam aftertaste. Very polished and balanced.	
2002 Wolf Blass `Platinum' Shiraz	170.00
Heady, meaty and peppery aromas of blackberries, raspberries, cassis and mulberries are lifted by lightly smoky/cedary oak, black pepper and spicy nuances of clove and nutmeg.	

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
